**PATRIOTISM:** Believing we live in the best country on earth and should be proud of it, we tried to get enough full-color permanent vinyl flags for all our members. We got just 100. If one is enclosed, please stick it on your coach at once (good spot is top-center on windshield glass or on rear hatch cover). These are reflective too, which may help prevent a collision from front or rear some dark rainy night.



**RENEWALS:** Again the time has come for renewing memberships for the new year. **UNDERWATER FILM:** Did anyone discover an extra tray of Scubba Diving Slides in amongst his possessions? Len Ryerson is missing a borrowed tray evidently misplaced while at Sedona. Please contact him or your editor if you found it.

**HOT AIR HEATER:** If the tubing that carries heat to the register in 6-cylinder coaches becomes worn, you can most easily replace it with plastic-covered 4-inch Clothes Drier tube available at most Appliance Service Shops. Be sure to fully stretch it out when installing - you'll need two pieces each 22" long. We changed ours long ago (with this white 4" flex) and it costs less but is lasting much longer than the original fabric-covered type. Get 4 Band-Clamps to hold it.

**DIRECTORS:** Under the Club's excellent system of staggered-retirement for the Board of Directors (to assure some continuity of good management), at last we have now served out our 3-year term. As first president of the club, then elected secretary, treasurer, etc., etc., a little rest will be welcomed. It is the fine custom with clubs to elect as Directors the immediate past President and his wife, not only as an honor but also so as not to lose all the excellent talent, plus the actual experience and ability they have gained. A great big welcome should be extended to Kathy and Phil at the coming election.

**OIL INDICATOR:** The engine oil pressure sensor (located near the Alternator on 6-cylinder UVs) has failed for at least a couple members this past year. This is a low percentage out of over 400 coaches, but worth mention. It appears that the bakelite insulator occasionally will crack from heat, squirting oil all over. If this happens on the road, simply drive a wooden plug into the hole for temporary repair. Your editor carries a spare Sensor - about \$3 at Chevy dealers. Perhaps raising the Sensor up with a 3" piece of pipe, away from the hot engine block, will eliminate failure. Some came from the factory raised, but members #459 and #476 had "vibration-fatigue" of the iron pipe. Bill suggests members replace it with stainless or high-strength pipe.

**ANOTHER YEAR:** We take this opportunity to wish every member prosperity and happiness all through the year of 1971. We also want to wish the Club success and growth, especially in helpfulness and service to the membership, during the next 12-months. Happy New Year.

**THANK YOU:** Your editor again says, "Thanks" to those who sent in material or suggestions for the CLUB NEWS issues the past year. Many of you have swapped tales on actual experiences, maintenance, modifications, malfunctions, techniques, ideas. We haven't been able to write them all up yet... most have been. Thank you again. 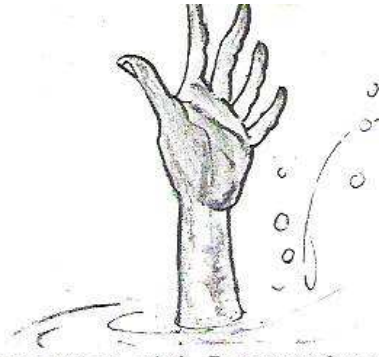

HELP - ITTCA: Members, should your club continue connection with International Travel & Trailer Clubs of America, Inc. during 1971? As you know, \$5 annually has been sent them for each Ultra member each year the past four years. Your decision will be voted at our next meeting and this is written notice as required by Ultra Club by-laws. Please give this question wise consideration.

HELP - NAPA: Regarding the item in this month's Club News, "Trouble in Napa" - your friends request HELP. Is there anyone near there who will volunteer to check up on this, and then report back. Thanks.

HELP - PARK CRUSADE: Rangers in all our National Parks enforce this rule - "No Overnight Resting" except in designated camping areas. Many owners of completely self contained rigs such as our Ultra Vans, believe this is stupid; we are not "campers" like those with tents or others not completely "contained". Our MODERN vehicles need new consideration. No daily need to make frantic reservations, or backtrack maybe 20 miles to a designated camp, or worry about your space being taken as the day wanes, and the like. 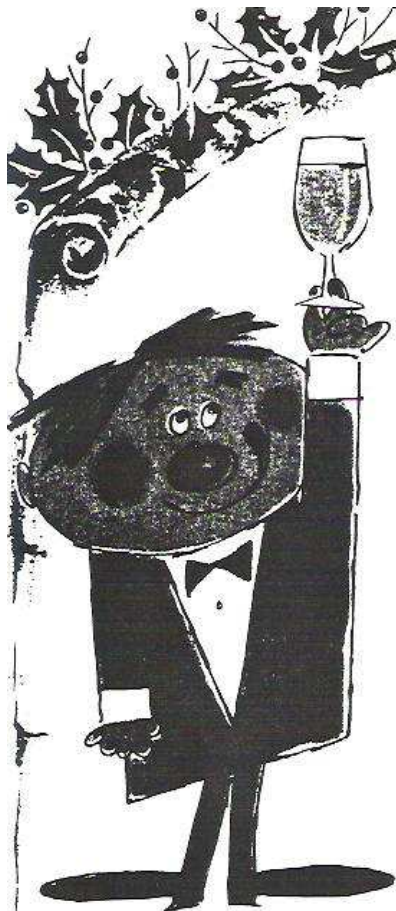
