WE HAVE OFTEN BEEN ASKED WHY CERTAIN COMPONENTS BREAK DOWN OR FAIL AFTER THE VEHICLE HAS BEEN IDLE FOR A LONG TIME AND THEN TAKEN OUT ON THE ROAD. IT MUST BE REMEMBERED THAT THERE ARE GREMLINS AT WORK ON THE VAN ALL THE TIME AND YOU SEE THE RESULTS OF THEIR MISCHIEF WHEN SOMETHING GOES HAYWIRE. THESE GREMLINS MAY BE GIVEN THE FOLLOWING NAMES: CONTRACTION & EXPANSION, DUE TO EXTREMES IN TEMPERATURE. CORROSION

AND RUSTING, GOING ON ALL THE TIME. DAMPNESS & CONDENSATION. SMOG, DUST, GRIT. HARDENING OR SOFTENING OF RUBBER & PLASTIC PARTS. VIBRATION, METAL FATIGUE, WHICH CAUSE PARTS TO SHAKE LOOSE OR FAIL. LOTS OF THESE GREMLINS MAY INTERACT WITH EACH OTHER AND ARE CONSTANTLY AT WORK. YOU MAY PARK YOUR VAN ONE DAY. EVERYTHING MAY BE IN PERFECT RUNNING CONDITION. A WEEK LATER YOU START IT UP AND HEAD FOR THE HILLS. SOMETHING BREAKS OR MALFUNCTIONS. THE GREMLINS HAVE BEEN AT WORK. THIS GENERAL CHECK LIST, ALTHOUGH NECESSARILY BRIEF, DOES NOT GUARANTEE THAT YOUR TRAVELING HOME WILL REMAIN COMPLETELY GREMLIN PROOF, BUT IT WILL HELP. OCCASIONALLY, WHEN YOU HAVE SOME SPARETIME, EQUIP YOURSELF WITH A SCREW DRIVER, PLIERS AND SOME WRENCHES - AND A CAN OF WD-40. GO THROUGH THE WHOLE VAN CAREFULLY, INSIDE AND OUT, FROM TOP TO BOTTOM. LOOK AT EVERYTHING WITH A CRITICAL EVE. HERE ARE A FEW EXAMPLES. YOU CAN PROBABLY FIND A LOT MORE. START WITH YOUR OUTSIDE MIRRORS. CHECK FASTENINGS AND ALIGNMENT. CHECK ALL YOUR LAMPS FOR PROPER OPERATION AND ALIGNMENT. IF YOU HAVE TIME, REMOVE LENSES, CLEAN REFLECTORS AND LAMP BULBS, SCRAPE CONTACTS. GET HEADLAMPS CHECKED FOR PROPER ALIGNMENT AT ANY GARAGE. SPRAY INSIDE OF HEADLAMP HOUSING WITH WD-40. WINDSHIELD WIPERS. CHECK FOR PROPER OPERATION AND TRAVEL. SPRAY WD-40 INTO AND AROUND PIVOTS. SPRAY RUBBER BLADES AND WIPE OFF. THIS WILL PRESERVE THEM. LOOK AROUND THE WHOLE VAN FOR SIGNS OF LEAKS, ESPECIALLY AROUND WINDOWS AND JOINTS. SCRAPE ANY SUSPICIOUS LOOKING PLACES AND APPLY DAP "33" GLAZING COMPOUND - OBTAINABLE AT ANY HARDWARE STORE - THEN WIPE SMOOTH WITH A RAG DAMPENED WITH TURPENTINE OR PAINT THINNER. GET UNDER THE VAN, IF YOU CAN, AND GO OVER ALL THE SHEET METAL SCREWS HOLDING THE PANS. LOOK AT THE CONTROL CABLES. SPRAY WITH WD-40. SEE THAT BRACKETS ARE IN PLACE AND TIGHT. CHECK THROTTLE CABLE AT REAR END WHERE IT FASTENS TO A BRACKET ON THE SIDE OF THE TRANSMISSION. SOME HAVE COME LOOSE. WHILE YOU ARE DOWN THERE LICK AT YOUR BRAKE LINES. CHECK FOR LEAKS AND FOR SIGNS OF ABRASION. LOOK AT YOUR ENGINE AND TRANSMISSION PANS . TIGHTEN BOUTS IF NECESSARY - BUT DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN . CHECK ALL SHOCK ABSORBERS FOR SIGNS OF LEAKS AND BE SURETHAT ALL FASTENINGS ARE SECURE. ALL SHOCKS SHOULD HAVE THAT BIG RUBBER SNUBBER AT THE TOP. LOOK AT YOUR STEERING SYSTEM VERY CAREFULLY. CHECK ALL PIVOT POINTS. SEE THAT ALL BOLTS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL NUTS ARE SECURED AND HAVE LOCK WASHERS OR COTTER PINS. WIPE OFF EXCESS GREASE FROM ALL PIVOT POINTS AND BALL JOINTS AND APPLY GREASE TO ALL ZERK FITTINGS. YOU CAN DO THIS WITH A SMALL, HAND GREASE GUN. LOOK AT THE CLIP WHICH HOLDS YOUR SPEEDOMETER CABLE TO THE INSIDE OF THE LEFT FRONT WHEEL. MAKE SURE THAT THIS CUP IS TIGHT AND THAT THERE ARE NO SHARP BENDS IN THE CABLE. LOOK AT THE MUFFLER BRACKETS AND CLAMPS FOR SIGNS OF LOOSENESS . THERE ARE DOZENS OF PLACES UNDER THE VAN WHERE OUR LITTLE GREMLINS LIKE TO WORK . LACK OF SPACE PREVENTS YOUR REPORTER FROM LISTING EVERYTHING IN DETAIL. THE IDEA IS TO LOOK EVERYWHERE, INSIDE AND OUT, FOR SIGNS OF CORROSION, LOOSE SCREWS & BOLTS, LEAKS, ETC. DON'T SKIMP ON THE WD-40. IT SURE KEEPS THOSE GREMLINS IN LINE. THOSE FOAM BUMPERS HAVE BEEN A SORE SPOT FOR MANY VAN OWNERS. ONCE THEY START TO CRUMBLE THERE IS NOT MUCH YOU CAN DO. A COAT OF GOOD FLEXIBLE PAINT, SUCH AS SINCLAIRS NO. 250 WHITE, PUT ON WHEN THE BUMPERS ARE NEW, OR BEFORE THEY HAVE GONE TOO FAR WILL MAKE THEM LAST A LOT LONGER. FUTURE ISSUES OF CLUB NEWS WILL CONTAIN INFORMATION ON WHEELS, BRAKES, WATER SYSTEMS & TANKS, BATTERIES AND DETAILED INFO ON HOW TO KEEP THAT THRONE GRINDER GOING. WOMEN'S LIB SAYS THAT ANY OF THE ABOVE JOBS SHOULD BE DUCK SOUP FOR ULTRA QUEENS.

IF YOU DO NOT UNDERSTAND ELECTRICITY, OR ARE NOT ABSOLUTELY SURE OF WHAT YOU ARE DOING, OR HAVE ANY DOUBTS ABOUT IT, WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU LEAVE IT ALONE. CAUTION: DO NOT INSTALL DURING DAMP OR RAINY WEATHER. DO NOT USE WHERE LITTLE KIDS WITH INQUISITIVE FINGERS MAY BE AROUND. BETTER TO SIT IN THE DARK OR LIGHT A CANDLE THAN TO TAKE A CHANCE. IF YOU DECIDE TO MAKE, HERE ARE THE MATERIALS AND INSTRUCTIONS:

2½ FT. OF 600 V. ROMEX TYPE UF, 12/2, WITH GROUND WIRE. ONE DUPLEX 3-WIRE OUTLET BOX, (WEATHERPROOF PREFERRED). TWO PIECES OF 1/8" I. D. COPPER TUBING, 3"LONG EACH. ONE ALLIGATOR CLIP. PLASTIC ELECTRICAL TAPE. ONE 12" PIECE STRANDED GREEN WIRE.

MHITE (COMMON)

TAPE

GREEN (GROUND). OUTLET BOX

COPPER TUBING (SEE INSTRUCTIONS)

WHITE

COMMON.

LARGER SLOT

GROUND

BLACK (HOT)

REMOVE OUTER (GRAY) INSULATION FROM EACH END OF ROMEX LEAVING WHITE AND BLACK SMALLER SLOT INSULATED WIRES UNDISTURBED. THE GROUND WIRE IS BARE. REMOVE 5" FOR BOX END AND 10" AT OPPOSITE THE WHITE END. CONNECT ROMEX TO BOX MAKING CERTAIN THAT, WIRE GOES TO THE POST WITH LONGER OF TWO SLOTS.

(ALL MODERN BOXES HAVE SOCKETS WITH TWO SIZES OF SLOTS). AT OTHER END OF ROMEX, REMOVE APPROXIMATELY ONE INCH OF INSULATION FROM BLACK & WHITE WIRES. SLIP A PIECE OF COPPER TUBING OVER EACH OF THE EXPOSED WIRES, AS FAR AS WIRES ARE BARED, AND FLATTEN THE WHOLE LENGTH OF THE TUBING WITH A HAMMER OR IN A VISE. THIS HOLDS FIRMLY AND MAKES THE TWO BLADES FOR PLUGGING THE THIEF INTO THE OUTLETS. DRESS THESE BLADES WITH A FILE UNTIL THEY FIT SNUGLY INTO THE SHORTER OF THE TWO SLOTS IN THE OUTLET. THE BLADES WILL THEN FIT INTO MOST OUTLETS YOU WILL ENCOUNTER. TAPE THE JUNCTION OF THE WIRES AND TUBING HEAVILY LEAVING APPROX 14 OF EXPOSED BLADE. FASTEN GREEN WIRE TO GROUND WIRE & ATTACH ALLIGATOR CLIP. SKETCH BELOW SHOWS METHOD OF INSTALLING THE THIEF. BEST REGARDS, TYPICAL 220 V. SOCKET (MOBILE HOME PARKS)
