Cactus Corvair Club hosts Phoenix Mini

Where was I in '62? Why I was in high school in central Florida. Where were you? And where was I in '82? Well, I was in Phoenix, Arizona, on April 16, 17, 18 to help the Cactus Corvair Club celebrate their 20th birthday!

And what a weekend it was as 168 official registrants representing 22 CORSA Chapters plus unaffiliated CORSA members from six states attended the CORSA-sanctioned miniconvention hosted by Cactus Corvair Club.

Things started happening Friday morning with registration and flea marketeers with the remainder of the day sort of laid back in the beautiful Arizona spring weather (spelled s-u-m-m-e-r to you northerners!). That evening 172 people attended the 60's Party with a group of attendees dressed in authentic 60's attire. A trivia contest was conducted as those at the party watched a super slide presentation and listened to music and commercials on KCCC radio (Get it? K-Cactus-Corvair-Club, snicker!). Bruce Allred of San Joaquin CORSA scored 73 points to win the contest, just beating out Lynda Lange of the host club who scored 72. Third place went to Ron Norquist of Rocky Mountain CORSA with 66. It was a tough guiz with both Corvair and non-Corvair trivia.

Following the party, a large group took a

morning as attendees voted for their favorites in the parking lot beauty contest while concours entrants feverishly finished their cars prior to judging. Members of the Tucson Corvair Club conducted the concours using CORSA rules and did a superb job! It was one of the most efficiently run concours I have attended and the one with the least number of complaints (which you always get!), particularly when you consider that it was an officially sanctioned event. The stakes were high as 32 entrants competed for Seniors Division promotions. Bob Lamb of Cerritos, CA, and a member of Vintage CORSA took a class win in Early Street Stock - Open with his '64 Spyder, scoring 91.06 and earning the only promotion to Seniors Division given at the event. Frank McKenna's Senior's Division Early Open '64 Spyder scored 93.38 to take best of show. Frank is a member of the Tucson club that conducted the concours and you better believe that he got a thorough going over but even with the extra tough judging still came out on top.

While the concours was going on, a large number of people competed in the various games. They were tough! Since I was somewhat laid up, I couldn't ride the three-wheeler through the slalom course, but I did try all the other events scoring a TOTAL of zero (spelled 0) points.

Saturday evening, 275 people trekked out to

Besides the 12,138 (give or take a few thousand) door prizes given away, the highlight of the evening was the presentation of concours

trophies.

Sunday morning dawned bright and clear (so what else is new?) and competitors scrambled to get their cars ready for the slalom and gymkhana events. Held in the parking lot of the fabulous Metro Center Mall, the slalom was without a doubt the most professionally run event I have ever been to and the course was a challenge to even the most seasoned Solo II competitors.

The gymkhana saw 24 entries with the Tom

Competition in the slalom was tough in all classes except Pure Stock 5 (Forward Control) as John Lee fairly swept the event. Since he was the only competitor, it really wasn't that hard. (In all fairness though, he really put his FC through its paces and his times were respectable for even some of the car classes!) But the climax of the day

was Harlan Colburn's third run turning a 58.051 with no penalties to earn Fast-Time-of-the-Day!

All during the three-day event, competitors could run the informal rally that gave each one an excellent tour of Phoenix and the surrounding area. Seventeen participants ran the course with Tom & Pam Schrum scoring 53 points to win the event.

The conclusion of the events came Sunday afternoon when trophies were presented for slalom and gymkhana plus the overall participation trophy, aptly called the "Golden Fanbelt Award." The Golden Fanbelt Award is similar to the national Ed Cole Award and is given for overall participation and scoring. Local club member Tom Schrum scored 629.25 points (of a maximum 730) to take home the gold. Besides fighting his hayfever the whole time, Tom won the

OK, guys, the next Phoenix Mini is scheduled for 1984. Plan now because you don't want to




