

REPLACEMENT OF TOILET GRINDER PUMP IN UNITS THROUGH #410

JABSCO pump #17260-0012. This is a macerator pump and works much better than the original "Chopper" pump. You will buy a new plastic mounting ring. The new pump fits inside the new ring, with a clearance of about 1/8 inch. Drill 3 holes around the top of the new mounting ring. Drill 3 corresponding holes through the top piece of the pump (which is removable). Use nuts and bolts to secure them as one piece, and fill in the gap with epoxy. Let set. Mount the new ring just as the old metal one was, hook up the power the same, and the hose the same. After you have removed the toilet (which is necessary), you will see how easy this job is. I had to do this in 1980, and it's been working great ever since. Any good RV store will have all of the parts.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

We should all carry them. The best to have is the HALON 1221. Most manufacturers have this type. The best part is it's non-corrosive. Since we have aluminum bodies and engines, CO2 will make a mess and eat through the engine block and body. I've seen this happen on Corvair engines. HALON is clean and does a better job of smothering a fire. It's more expensive, but compared to the damage that can be done by the other extinguishers it's cheap. I carry a 5-pounder by the entrance door, and a 2-1/2 pounder next to the rear closet area. Look in your Yellow Pages under the heading "Fire Extinguishers". Any dealer will be happy to explain full details.
